For Foreigners Working in Companies

Even when the new coronavirus (COVID-19) has caused a decrease in business for the company, foreign workers are not allowed to be treated less favorably than Japanese workers just because they are foreigners.

- 1. Company must pay a <u>leave allowance</u> to Japanese as well as foreign workers when they are forced to take days off from work by the company.
- 2. The <u>subsidy</u> the national government pays companies to protect worker employment can be used for Japanese as well as foreign workers.
- 3. When you take days off from work because your children's schools are closed, you can use <u>paid</u> <u>vacation days</u> just like Japanese workers.
- 4. Companies cannot freely fire you at will. When a company wants to fire a foreign worker, **the same rules as Japanese workers** must be followed.
